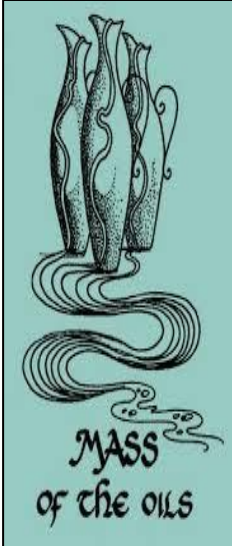

The Karing Kitchen offers basic, nutritional meals to all who come, five days a week, 52 weeks a year.

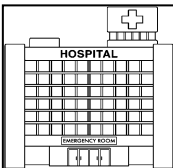
In order for this service to continue more volunteers are required.

Parishioners in Hospital

Parishioners in Moncton City Hospital and the Georges Dumont Hospital are reminded that if they wish to receive a visit from the parish priest, it is necessary to specifically identify themselves as being members of St. Bernard's parish when they are admitted to hospital. The clergy visiting lists for priests and pastoral care visitors are printed out according to parish identification. This means that if you haven't identified yourself as belonging to our parish, the priest or pastoral care visitors will not be aware that you have been admitted to hospital and thus will not be able to visit. Due to changes in the "Privacy Act", PARISHIONERS IN HOSPITAL are reminded that if they wish a visit from a Priest, or to receive Holy Communion while in hospital, it is necessary to specifically identify themselves as being members of St. Bernard's parish and to state that "they wish to request a visit from a priest or from a member of the Parish Pastoral Care team." If they wish to receive a visit from the parish pastoral team, parishioners at the Georges Dumont Hospital are asked to contact the St. Bernard's parish office.



Next Sunday, April 9th is Palm Sunday

We celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem, the week before his death and resurrection. Palm Sunday is also referred to as "Passion Sunday." It marks the beginning of Holy Week, which concludes on Easter Sunday. When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds greeted him by waving palm branches and covering his path with palm branches. Immediately following this great time of celebration in the ministry of Jesus, he begins his journey to the cross.

Public Service Announcement Advance Care Planning information sessions- Moncton

April 13, 2017– In recognition of National Advance Care Planning Day, Horizon Health Network and Vitalité Health Network, together with the New Brunswick Hospice Palliative Care Association (NBHPCA) are hosting free public sessions on planning for future healthcare needs.

Patients, families and health care professionals are invited to attend one of the sessions being held simultaneously on April 20.

English-only session – Thursday, April 20, at 7 PM at The Moncton Hospital, 135 MacBeath Ave., in Amphitheatre A. The session is hosted by Dr. Pam Mansfield, palliative medicine physician at The Moncton Hospital, assistant professor Dalhousie University, and past president of the NBHPCA.

French-only session – Thursday, April 20, at 7 PM at the Dr. Georges-L.-Dumont University Hospital Centre, 300 Université Avenue, in the Amphitheatre. The session is hosted by Dr. Renée Turcotte, associate clinical teacher, Université de Sherbrooke, Dieppe Family Medicine, and president of the NBHPCA.

These informative planning sessions will provide an opportunity to learn how to create a personalized advanced care plan and how to tell loved ones what would be important should they become ill and unable to communicate.

Advance Care Planning is a process of thinking about and sharing your wishes for future health and personal care needs. It involves deciding who will speak for you, if you can't speak for yourself. It is a way to give loved ones the confidence to make decisions for you during a difficult time.
