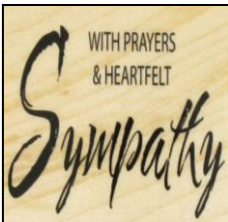

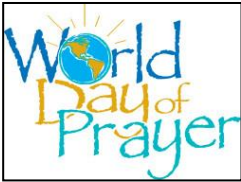
We pray for all those who serve and for families separated from their loved ones in the military; and for the strength they need to face this time of isolation and uncertainty.

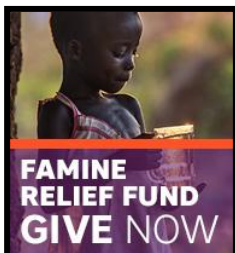

Faith leaders in Canada launch a national appeal in response to famines in South Sudan and extreme food shortages in Yemen, northeast Nigeria and Somalia: The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB) has joined many religious leaders in Canada in launching a joint campaign to raise emergency aid for the 20 million people in danger of starvation. Already many millions are already in that situation. Situations of war and violence are mainly responsible for this crisis. **The Government of Canada has created a "Famine Relief Fund". For every donation made before June 30, 2017, the federal government will contribute an equivalent amount to the "Famine Relief Fund".** If you can, give generously before June 30, 2017! Contributions however will be needed throughout the summer and well into the fall. **A special collection will be taken in all the churches of the diocese on June 24 and 25. The collection will be sent to Development and Peace. To receive a tax receipt issued from the parish, you will need to put your contribution in an envelope with your name, your envelope number and indicate the purpose for your donation (Famine Relief Fund).** For other ways to contribute you can visit the CCCB website at www.cecc.ca.
