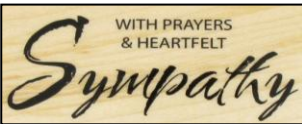

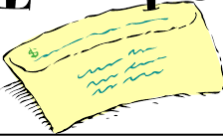

Bernard's to help out at the Karing Kitchen. Two volunteers are needed each Friday, every month, 8:30 AM to 1 PM.

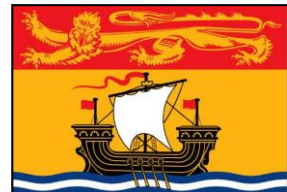
