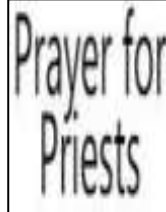
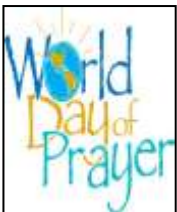

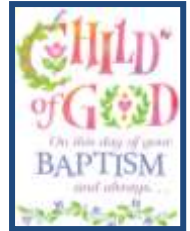
KARING KITCHEN
