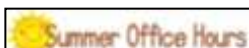

### Negotiations continue with the rectory sale and parking lot purchase on the north side of the church.

As expected, we are at a point where surveys, zoning applications, and ongoing assessments are being done before everything is

signed off. To complete the deal may take us into the early fall. The current owner of the parking lot leases the space to some downtown employees and as the transition occurs, there may be a period of time when a barricade or chain is in place at the entrance. This will be temporary and is part of the process while the sale is finalized, so we will continue with patience, prayer and planning in our work with this project.
