**Third World Day of the Poor, Sunday November 17, 2019** The **World Day of the Poor** is celebrated on the 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time since 2017. It was established by Pope Francis. "The hope of the poor shall not perish forever" (Ps 9:19) are words that remain timely. In the words of Pope Francis: It seems that the passage of time and the advances of civilization increase the number of poor rather than diminish them. Jesus who inaugurated his kingdom by placing the poor at the centre, wanted to tell us precisely this: he inaugurated the kingdom, but he has entrusted to us, his disciples, the task of carrying it forward with responsibility for giving hope to the poor. The credibility of our proclamation and the witness of Christians depend on it. No one must feel excluded.

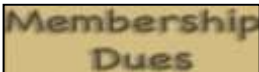

**All donations for 2019 must be received prior to December 31<sup>st</sup> to be included in 2019 taxation receipts. Thank you for your continued generosity !!**

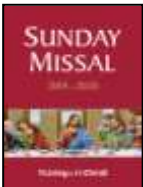


### 2020 CWL Dues Collection Dues are now payable and due by December 31<sup>st</sup>.
