Registering for Christmas Food Box

Like most things this year, planning will be different with the Christmas Food Boxes. St. Bernard's will be supporting 50 boxes and registering individuals for those boxes. You will need to call the St. Bernard's Social Justice line at 204-4882 and leave your name and a phone number where you can be reached. If we cannot reach you at that number, your name will not be able to be registered. The person phoning you back will provide all the details and answer questions you may have.

The list of 50 names we register through St. Bernard's will be sent to the Food Bank and the Christmas Box will be delivered or can be picked up from there. Please note, no boxes will be prepared or delivered from the church this year due to COVID-19 guidelines.

This year we will be paying the Food Depot Alimentaire directly to sponsor the 50 boxes St. Bernard's is supporting. Season of Advent:

The first Sunday of Advent - November 29th, 2020

Advent has a twofold nature: It prepares us for Christmas, when we recall Christ's first coming among us, and it is also a time when we look forward to his second coming at the end of the ages. Advent is a season of joyful expectation. During Advent, each Sunday's Gospel reading has a specific focus. The Old Testament readings, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times. The selections from the writings of the Apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.



Advent Reconciliation - Covid-19 has caused many things to be done a differently than normal and our Advent Reconciliation will be no exception. There will be a Reconciliation Preparation Service on Thursday, December 10th at 7:00 p.m. at Immaculate Heart of Mary. This will not be sacramental, but rather a preparation for individual

confession. St. Bernard's parishioners can call the office and book an appointment for individual confession for Friday, December 11th after 9:30 AM Mass until Noon. December 10ths liturgy will be live-streamed on Facebook, so if you cannot be there in person, you will be able to participate online.
